Charge

- to formally accuse someone of committing a crime;
- to use property as security for a debt (such as a mortgage); or
- a direction given by a judge to tell the jury what they must do.

Order

- an order to do work in the community without pay. If
- someone has been convicted of a crime they may be
- given a community service order as an alternative to
- being sent to prison.

Land

- the buildings built on the land;
- the subsoil;
- the airspace above the land necessary for ordinary use of the land; and
- property fixed to the land.

Money laundering

making money from crime and then passing it through a business to make it appear legitimate

Prosecution

the name for the team of people (lawyers and so on) bringing proceedings against someone else. Also when legal proceedings are taken against someone it is called a prosecution.
